


UNIQUE LAKE POSITION

The cottage community here is tightknit and well-organized, ensuring the maintenance of roads and shared infrastructure, making access easy even during peak seasons.







DESCRIPTION

THE COTTAGE

This classic Linwood-style cedar cottage is designed for both comfort and longevity. Unlike modern builds requiring frequent maintenance, its cedar and white pine interior ensures a warm, rustic charm while keeping upkeep to a minimum. The vaulted ceiling in the main living area is a rare architectural feature, built with 2x10 thick cedar planks—a nearly impossible luxury to replicate today.

The adjoining sunroom, wrapped in large glass windows, offers panoramic views of Lake Winnipeg and a perfect space for morning coffee, afternoon reading, or evening gatherings. A spacious west-facing deck provides stunning sunset views and ample opportunity for outdoor entertaining.
